



COVID-19 Camper Information

We hope this message finds you and your families safe and healthy. This has been a confusing and difficult time for all of us. Since things are changing daily, we are going to use this document to provide you with the most up-to-date information from Avalon Campground during this unprecedented time.

Our County and State officials have been issuing guidance and directives almost daily. We need to follow all the rules they establish, while making our own decisions to protect our customers and employees.

CAMPGROUND OPENING

- Avalon Campground was opened on May 11, 2020 for Season Campers Only. Our new season dates will be May 11th – November 15th.
- As of May 28th, all visitors are permitted. We ask that you exercise good judgement when inviting guests to your summer home and you must follow all rules.

SHORT TERM CAMPING

- As of May 28, 2020, we are now open for all short-term camping. This was authorized by NJ Executive Order 148 and confirmed by Cape May County Freeholder resolution on May 26, 2020.
- As the current rules stand, all events are suspended until the government allows them.
- The following amenities are temporarily closed based on Executive Order 133 and past orders:
 - Game Room
 - Lounge
 - Mini - Golf
 - Playgrounds
 - Basketball Court
 - Restrooms
- The following restrooms are currently opened:
 - Bath House #1
 - Bath House #2

This bath house will be open but due to Covid-19 we encourage everyone with a self-contained unit to use their own bathroom to limit their exposure. This also helps to protect the transient guests who do not have facilities in their equipment or our cabins.

CAMPGROUND OFFICE & STORE

- Our office is open during normal business hours and can be reached at 609-624-0075. We will be handling customers at the temporary counter outside the camp office window.
- Our store is currently closed but items can be purchased thru the window if necessary. Limited stock is available at this time, please call to check availability.
- Propane can be purchased at the office window during normal office hours.

Pools

The pool at Avalon Campground will open on June 22 per Governor Murphy. Restrictions will apply for your safety:

- Everyone must "Bring Their Own Chair"
- NO Rafts, Noodles or Toys will be permitted in the pool.
- We will have one gate as ENTRANCE and another as EXIT.
- Campers must stay 6 feet from other families.
- Masks are required on the pool deck. Lifeguards and children under 2 years are not required to wear a mask.
- Please do not wear your Mask in the pool.
- Frequently touched areas will be sprayed with disinfectant on a regular basis.
- If you are showing signs of illness please refrain from entering the pool area.

We thank you for your patience, it is difficult to keep up with the ever-changing regulations. We will update the COVID-19 link on our website if anything should change. Campers must stay 6 feet from other families.

CAMPGROUND COVID-19 POLICIES

- ***Anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19 or who has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 is not permitted in Avalon Campground at any time.***
 - **Individuals who have recovered from COVID-19 and have been cleared by a public health official, can enter our campground.**
 - **Individuals exposed to COVID-19 and not showing symptoms must wait, the CDC required 14-day period of no-symptoms in order to enter Avalon Campground.**

Policies for Camping at Avalon Campground under COVID-19 Restrictions:

- As usual, all individuals in the resort must be able to remove themselves from the campground at any time. In other words, everyone must have a vehicle on site and the ability to depart the resort in their vehicle.
- Campers are confined to their campsites under the same set of rules that NJ homeowners are currently confined to for residential homes.
- Outdoor groups of 100 people are now permitted per NJ Executive Order 148, but everyone in the group needs to be 6 feet apart unless you live together.
- Social Distancing is mandated in the campground at all times.
- You must wear a mask when inside campground facilities and when interacting with people outside of your campsite. Walking the campground with a mask is not required; however, if you choose to stop and interact with people, then wearing a mask is recommended.
- Campfires are allowed at individual campsites, subject to the current social distancing and group restrictions.
- Packages for campers will not be accepted. We recommended calling Postnet (609) 624-8750 if you need to make arrangements for packages.

COMMUNICATIONS:

- Regarding communication about COVID-19 and any changes to our schedule will be updated on our website.
- We will also use Mail Chimp Service to communicate to all our campers. Please make sure your email address with our office is up to date. If you have unsubscribed from our email list in the past, we will be unable to email you.
- We will also be using social media to communicate.
